HOST RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

Wanaka Ski and Snowsports Club takes seriously its responsibility to provide a comfortable and safe environment at events where it serves alcohol. It has therefore adopted the following policy.

1. Alcohol will not be served to members or guests who visibly appear to be intoxicated, who will be asked to leave the premises and encouraged to use safe transport options. We do not accept aggressive or violent behaviour.
2. It is against the law to serve alcohol to minors. If bar staff are in doubt about your age, they will ask for identification. Acceptable forms of proof of age are an NZ photo driver's licence, an 18+ Evidence of Age card or a current passport.
3. Food such as sandwiches and savouries will always be available.
4. The club will provide non-alcoholic drinks which at a minimum will include free tap water and fruit juices.
5. Members and their guests will be encouraged to use safe transport options to get home after events at which alcohol is available. Bar staff will always have phone numbers for local taxi firms and will call them for you on request.
