Grassroots Funding Policy

Wanaka Snowsports Club [WSC] Grassroots funding assists with snow sports development programmes for primary school aged children from Year 2- 8. For the 2023 season a maximum of 25 Grassroots awards are available.

Applicants must have held an active family membership for at least one year prior to application and have participated and volunteered in club events during that year.

Awards will be paid directly to Cardrona/Treble Cone or Snow Farm for WSC approved programmes in any snow sports discipline.

Recipient families must agree to:

- Submit at least two reports to grants@wanakasnowsports.co.nz. These reports should include feedback on skills progress, personal successes and photographs if possible for posting on the club's Facebook and Instagram pages and local media. An online form will be available to assist children.
- Volunteer to assist the club with Grassroots and club events on or off snow. Training and safety procedures briefings will be given prior to any on snow participation.

Off-snow roles include active Committee membership, organising or assisting with WSC's calendared events. These include; Snowsports Gear Sale, Grassroots and Welcome to Winter events, Snowmelt Fundraiser and Alpine Race Organisation (ROC) volunteering. Roles include setting up venues, BBQ preparations. serving food/ drinks, cleaning up and removing rubbish.

On-snow roles for ROC* (predominantly during weekends) include assisting with time-keeping, gate-keeping, start marshalling, collecting bibs and distributing treats.

The club may decline to make an award If in the previous year award recipient families have not supported club Grassroots / club fun activities in a voluntary capacity or have not submitted two reports on their on-snow activities to the club.

Priority will be given to members who have previously given valuable volunteer time.

2023 Applications open online 9th May 2023 and close on 19th May 2023. No late applications considered.

*ROC Events - Snow Sports New Zealand offers training classes for any parents interested in taking volunteer roles further as their children participate in more events. WSC's Race Organising Committee organises and runs two Interfield races and numerous FIS and Youth races at Cardrona and Treble Cone to raise most of the funds that we distribute as Grants and Grassroots.
